As things can tend to become a trifle hectic towards the end of the year I write to provide you with end of year arrangements for girls in Year 12. Please read this carefully and contact the School if you have any queries.

The Formal

As you are aware a Committee has organised the Year 12 Formal at the Hobart Function Centre from 6.30pm for 7.00pm, to midnight on Tuesday 13 December. Attendance is by invitation only and these will be issued shortly.

The girls and their partners and parents are asked to arrive on time. It would be appreciated if girls introduce their partners to staff who may be in attendance upon arrival. At the Hobart Function Centre, the girls will be on licensed premises and some alcohol will be served on the tables to those over eighteen years of age. Parents are asked to take responsibility for this. Smoking is not permitted at the Formal.

The last two days before Study Week

On Thursday 3 November, a bus hired by the school will take all Year 12 girls at 5.00pm from school to the home of Mr and Mrs Ellis, "Meadowbank", Glenora, (telephone 6286 1269), the parents of Grace. We are grateful to them for offering their home. Some other parents will supervise the evening/night. This is a private function of which the School is aware but has been kindly organised by the parents so that the girls may spend a last evening together as a class. All girls must travel on the bus.

Girls are asked to bring a minimum of luggage, including a sleeping bag, pillow and sleeping mat. They may bring a tent if they wish. Girls are asked to bring \$10.00, to cover the costs of meat and breakfast, to Karen Di Benedetto by Monday 31 October. If they wish to bring additional items such as cheese, biscuits, cakes etc they may do so.

Girls are responsible for their belongings and are asked to clear up after their stay. They should bring any cutlery or plates they may need.

The bus will return to school on Friday 4 November, leaving Glenora at 7.00am and returning in time for the girls to complete arrangements for their final assembly. There will be no lessons at The Hutchins School or St Michael's Collegiate School on Friday 4 November and Fahan girls are not to go there at all.

Girls will help tidy their Common Room, empty all their lockers and be ready for their Farewell Assembly at 9.00am, after which they are invited to morning tea at 'Nateby' with the Staff. They will be dismissed to go home at about 10.45am taking their belongings with them.

Final Assembly


