



Course Credit

The School will include in the Course Handbook an indication of any pre-requisite learning that might preclude a student from attempting studies in a particular subject.

Applications for credit transfer of courses will be appraised by the Director of Studies and the results of this application made known to the student before the application is completed. Any credit transfer attained will be recorded on the student management database.

The School will provide a record of the course credit to the student for acceptance and signing by the two parties, and this document will then be placed on the student's file.

In the case of International students where the course credit may lead to a shortening of the student's course, the School will:

- where the course credit is granted before the student visa grant indicate to the student the actual net course duration (as reduced by course credit) in the confirmation of enrolment issued to the student, or
- if the course credit is granted after the student visa grant, report the change of course duration via PRISMS under section 19 of the ESOS Act.
