Lumina 9 Excursion

In order to give students the opportunity to use their skills in real life situations, as well as developing a sense of themselves as productive members of the wider community, we have developed relationships with a range of Community Organisations. These organisations are: Mara House 'Colony 47', Variety and Migrant Education. Helping community organisations is an integral part of the Lumina 9 program and we hope to encourage the girls to contribute in a meaningful way to assist groups within our community.

On Monday 4 March, the Lumina 9 girls will depart school at 12.30pm to have lunch and play sporting games with the students from the Migrant Education Centre at Nutgrove Beach. We are hoping to encourage the Migrant Students to have conversations with the girls and to use and improve their English skills in real life situations. The Migrant Education teachers hope for their students to build their confidence and share their stories with the Fahan girls about where they came from and their journey to Australia and their life in Hobart.

Girls are allowed to wear sporting uniform for the whole day and their Lumina 9 jackets. Please ensure that girls have a packed lunch on the day. Girls will be back at school 1.45pm in readiness for period 6 and 7.
