Uniform Guidelines and Mobile Phones

I would like to take this opportunity to remind everyone of the uniform guidelines. At Fahan we take pride in our uniform and the way we wear it and encourage our students to understand and be respectful of these expectations. If there is an unforeseen circumstance and a problem arises with uniform could you please ensure that a note is put in the school diary.

Further information can be found in the Junior School Handbook. The handbook is available online.

- Full PE uniform may be worn to and from school on PE days only. Girls are expected to change for sport training if required.
- Items from the sport uniform and formal uniform may not be combined.
- Bike shorts and softball pants may not be worn to and from school.
- No jewellery, except for a watch and one small ear-stud (not any other form of earring) in each ear lobe.
- Skirt length is mid knee.
- Hair ribbons and accessories in school colours only (no variations or interpretations please). These are available at the Uniform Shop.
- Shoulder length hair or longer needs to be tied back.
- All girls in Years 2-6 are required to wear their blazer with the formal uniform to and from school and when in public.

I would also like to also take this opportunity to remind everyone that students must not use their mobile phones during the school day. Mobiles are required to be switched off and remain in school bags during the school day. If you need to contact your daughter regarding an appointment or change of home arrangements, please leave a message via the Front Office.
