Equipment List

All students are to provide:

A pair of **runners or walking boots**.

A light **shower proof jacket** (not the school sports jacket).

A **swimming costume**.

A **hat and sunscreen**.

A **thermal top and bottoms** (can be used as pyjamas).

Students need their own **sleeping mat & sleeping bag**. (Tents are provided).

It is important that **only necessary clothing** is brought on camp. 1 small bag per person is allowed as bus space is limited.

Food, cooking utensils, stoves, fuel, a BBQ, plates, cutlery and solar showers are **all provided at the Kelvedon site**.
